

Notice

Notice is hereby given that the Parish Council of the Parish of South Head intend to apply to the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney for an ordinance to –

- (a) vary the trusts of property that was formerly held on trust for the Parish of Watson's Bay and the Parish of Vaucluse and Rose Bay so that it is held on trust for the amalgamated Parish of South Head, and
- (b) amend the *Watsons Bay Trust Ordinance 2012* to
 - (i) update certain language to reflect the current standard master trust ordinance approved by the Standing Committee,
 - (ii) update the leasing and licensing power to be in line with the current standard master trust ordinance approved by the Standing Committee,
 - (iii) update the review date so that the next date of review is in 2030, and
 - (iv) substitute all references to the 'Parish of Watsons Bay' with the 'Parish of South Head',
- (c) apply part of the capital of the trust fund to –
 - (i) meet the cost, by reimbursement or otherwise, of the Wardens paying the entitlements of the former Rector of the Parish of Watsons Bay in accordance with the terms of the amalgamation,
 - (ii) repair of the stonework and roof of St Peter's Church at Watson's Bay and the repair of the stonework at St Michael's Church at Vaucluse,
 - (iii) upgrading of the bathroom facilities of St Michael's Hall to provide an accessible toilet facility, a separate unisex toilet facility and new accessible access to the Hall,
 - (iv) upgrade of the access to and lighting of the Watsons Bay columbarium, and
 - (v) the repair and upgrade of the curate's cottage at 331a Old South Head Road Watsons Bay, and
- (d) further vary the trusts of certain funds held on trust for the Parish of South Head, so that \$900,000 of the funds will be held on trust for NCNC Fund Limited (New Churches for New Communities) for the purposes of the new ministry centre in the Parish of Leppington.

Any objections to the proposed Ordinance may be presented in accordance with the Ordinance Procedure Ordinance 1973 (as amended) to –

at any time before the expiration of 3 weeks from the date of posting of this notice.

If you do decide to send an objection, please ensure that it –

- (1) states your name and address, and
- (2) distinctly specifies the grounds of opposition.

Any personal information contained in an objection will be held in accordance with the Privacy Policy of the Sydney Diocesan Services (SDS).
