Whilst our Sydney community is in lockdown we are all very concerned about the people we support. We have had a flood of calls from people we support asking for help because they have lost work. People who wash cars, drive taxis, work in bars and as cleaners. People who are casual workers and cannot work from home.

During the last lockdown we maintained our services remotely, via home delivery and in person by appointment. We did not miss one day of supporting people when they really needed it.

During this lockdown and beyond, we will continue.
